

FRATERNAL EXPECTATIONS OF THE ALPHA DELTA PHI FRATERNITY

The ritual of Alpha Delta Phi includes the Covenant. The presentation of the Covenant is made to each new member upon his initiation and outlines the basic expectations that he will follow as a member of Alpha Delta Phi. The ritual of Alpha Delta Phi is secret; however, it closely parallels Fraternal Expectations as outlined by the National Inter-Fraternity Conference Committee on Values and Ethics. These include:

- I. I will know and understand the ideals expressed in my fraternity Ritual and will strive to incorporate them in my daily life.
- II. I will strive for academic achievement and practice academic integrity.
- III. I will respect the dignity of all persons; therefore I will not physically, mentally, psychologically or sexually abuse or haze any human being.
- IV. I will protect the health and safety of all human beings. I will respect my property and the property of others; therefore, I will neither abuse nor tolerate the abuse of property.
- V. I will meet my financial obligations in a timely manner.
- VI. I will neither use nor support the use of illegal drugs; and I will neither abuse nor support the abuse of alcohol.
- VII. I acknowledge that a clean and attractive environment is essential to both physical and mental health; therefore I will do all in my power to see that the chapter property is properly cleaned and maintained.
- VIII. I will challenge all my fraternity members to abide by these fraternity expectations and will confront those who violate them.
