OCTOBER 2021

Recognizing the difficulties faced by the undergraduate chapter which graduated over half of its membership in 2020, alumni began holding frequent meetings with chapter leadership in an effort to provide direction and support to the chapter.



These meetings saw Union alumni from all years in attendance, as the alumni were able to preserve chapter traditions by relaying this information directly to chapter leadership in order to keep its history alive. Paired with this, the alumni raised over \$16,000 to help supplement the chapter's budget and allow them to continue to operate despite being one of smaller brotherhoods in the entire fraternity. This sort of direct support was crucial to the chapter keeping its house with the school and allowed them to focus their efforts into growing the chapter.

NOVEMBER 2021

Resuming a popular tradition within the **Hamilton Chapter**, brothers looked their best as the chapter held their first charity gala since 2020. With all proceeds going to Tim Bergling Foundation for Mental Health, the chapter raised \$1,000. This was not the only philanthropy event for this fall from Hamilton, as the chapter also held a fundraiser for the Kelberman Center, a leading provider for autism services for children in the Mohawk Valley.
